General information to make it easier for you to plan your trip to Ljubljana and Slovenia.





Airports & transport from/to the airport

You can fly into all **nearby airports**: **Ljubljana**, **Zagreb**, **Trieste**, **Venice**, **and Vienna** to name just a few. Please choose the airport that is most convenient for you in terms of arrival time, connecting flights, and overall travel logistics.

Although Ljubljana Airport is the closest, it may not always be the most convenient option due to high airport taxes, which can make flight tickets more expensive.

If you choose to fly into **Zagreb, Venice**, or another nearby airport, you can easily arrange a transfer to your final destination (e.g., your hotel). We recommend checking <u>GoOpti</u> for reliable transfer services. Another option are <u>Nomago</u> or Lang Prevozi (+386 40 639 863), which is sometimes more affordable, or you can order a <u>taxi</u>.

Please note that even if you fly into **Ljubljana (Brnik) Airport**, you will still need transportation to the city center (it's about **25 km away**). We usually use **GoOpti** for this route as well.

Accommodation

For the **accommodation** we recommend you to check either a general website where you can find all the <u>hotels</u> in Ljubljana or go to the individual websites of the most popular hotels – listed below (the most expensive are on the top of the list – depending on the budget you intend to spend):
